Compliance status

This website is **partially compliant** with the requirements set out in appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard, due to the non-compliances listed below.

Non-accessible content

The content listed below is non-accessible for the following reason:

a) non-compliance with the Law of 9 January 2004, n. 4

- The glossary on the "Seminars and Training Courses" page is not keyboard-navigable;
- the "Time slot preference" selection on the "Contacts" page is not navigable with keyboard arrows;
- words written in an other language than the main language of the page are not announced with the correct pronunciation by screen readers;
- the cookie window has the following issues:
 - some links are not identifiable by the user with a color deficit because this is the only element that distinguishes them from static text;
 - the button to close the fixed cookie banner in the footer of the page is not reachable from the keyboard;
 - part of the content does not respond to the text spacing settings set by the user;
 - the Enel logo lacks alternative text;
 - some interactive elements (radio-buttons) do not meet the minimum color contrast requirements;
 - Some interactive elements (buttons) lack a label (name) for screen readers.

No accessible alternatives are currently available, as specific measures are being taken to the progressive resolution of the problems encountered.
